Local and national leaders present pediatric topics in their area of specialty during this weekly series.

Despite high literacy rates, global health literacy rates are poor. Though many factors influence health literacy rates, even highly educated people suffer from low health literacy. Using comics and graphics, in addition to text, helps to increase understanding of difficult terms and processes, while decreasing feelings of anxiety, isolation, and lack of control over healthcare. In this workshop, attendees will learn how to how to incorporate affordable graphics, how to engage clients with graphic medicine and opening understandable dialogues to facilitate self-efficacy and health equity.

Objectives:

At the conclusion of this activity, the participant will be able to:

1 Examine how to incorporate affordable graphics to increase public and personal health literacy.

2 Discuss how to engage patients and families with graphic medicine to improve understanding of the healthcare journey.

3 Analyze how graphic medicine reduces stigmas, feelings of isolation, and facilitates open communication to facilitate selfefficacy and health equity.
