Keller, MD is Professor and Vice Chair for Clinical Strategy and Transformation in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Colorado School of Medicine and Children's Hospital Colorado, where he practices primary care pediatrics in a safety-net clinic, teaches students and residents about health policy and child advocacy and works to develop value-based systems of care for children and adolescents. He is currently chair-elect of the Pediatric Policy Council and serves as co-chair of the Legislative and Policy Committee of the Colorado Chapter of the AAP.

Prior to moving to Colorado, Dr. Keller spent 22 years on the faculty of the University of Massachusetts School of Medicine, where he practiced primary care pediatrics, initiated novel community-based programs with a variety of collaborators, served as an Associate Medical Director for Medicaid in Massachusetts and administered Rhode Island's All-Payer Primary Care initiative. He was a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Health Policy Fellow in the office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation at the US Department of Health and Human Services, served as President of the Academic Pediatric Association (APA) and is a past Chair of the Federation of Pediatric Organizations.
