

Dr. Ram Chettiar is a Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist at Children's Mercy Kansas City, with faculty appointments as a Clinical Associate Professor in Pediatrics and Psychiatry at the University of Missouri-Kansas City and as a Clinical Assistant Professor in Psychiatry at the University of Kansas Medical Center.
